The Transverse Myelitis Association (TMA) is a non-profit advocacy organization dedicated to advancing research and clinical care and providing support through networking and education to those affected by rare neuro-immune disorders - acute disseminated encephalomyelitis (ADEM), MOG antibody-associated disease, neuromyelitis optica spectrum disorder (NMOSD), optic neuritis (ON) and transverse myelitis (TM), including acute flaccid myelitis (AFM). Our stakeholders include individuals diagnosed with rare neuro-immune disorders and their families/friends, clinicians, scientists and supporters.

In 1999, the TMA held its first international symposium about rare neuro-immune disorders, with more than 100 attendees from all over the world. Since then, we have held a symposium every other year to bring together individuals diagnosed with rare neuro-immune disorders and the clinicians and researchers that focus on these disorders

As part of our continued commitment and mission to improve the quality of life of individuals diagnosed with rare neuro-immune disorders, the **2018 Regional Rare Neuro-immune Disorders Symposium (RNDS)** will be held on Oct 27, 2018 at the Joseph B. Martin Conference Center, Harvard Medical School, Boston, MA.

Hosted by The Transverse Myelitis Association (TMA), and Boston Children's Hospital Center for Pain and The Brain, the symposium is dedicated to the exchange of information regarding diagnosis, research, and treatment strategies, and to providing an opportunity to bring together the community of individuals diagnosed with these rare neuro-immune disorders, families, caregivers, and the medical professionals who have interest and are specializing in these disorders.
